

He has to do his schoolwork in a special caravan with the other children who belong to the circus. Their school is a very long way away. The school sends out the work for the children to do and one of the parents helps them. They also have lessons over the telephone and computer. Then the children are able to speak to their teachers.

Most of the children enjoy working in the circus and love the excitement of the music and the crowds of people watching them. It can be very tiring though as often there are two performances every day and schoolwork has to be fitted in too. The children also have to help to set up the circus tents and to pack them away again when they move on to a new town.

Much of the time is spent living in a caravan and practicing, practicing and practicing, so although it would be fun to live and work in a circus it is also very hard work.
